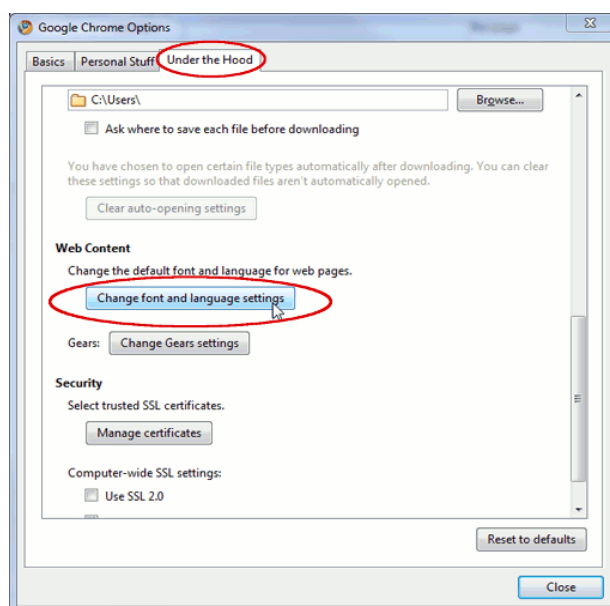
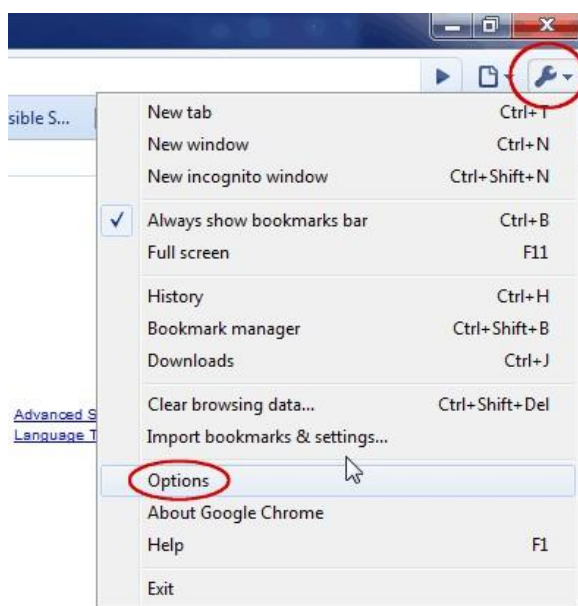


Change Default Text Size in Chrome

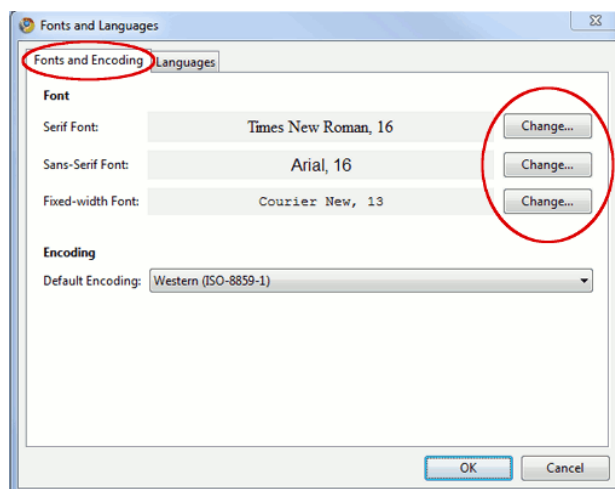
Step 1: Open the 'Fonts and language settings' window

1. Click on the **Wrench menu icon** at the top right of your browser (see below left).
2. Click on **'Options'** in the drop-down menu (see below left).
3. In the 'Google Chrome Options', click the **'Under the Hood'** tab (see below right).
4. Click on the 'Change font and language settings' button (see below right).



Step 2: Choose the font size for all web pages you visit

1. In the 'Fonts and Languages' window, select the **'Fonts and Encoding'** tab.
2. Click the **'Change'** button beside the font style you wish to change (Serif Font, Sans-Serif Font or Fixed-width Font).
3. In the 'Font' window (see below), click on the font size you want. Click the **'OK'**



- button. This returns you to the 'Fonts and Languages' window.
- Click '**OK**' once again to return to the 'Google Chrome Options' window.
 - Click the '**Close**' button to finish and return to Google Chrome.
